Deductive Arguments



A **Deductive** Argument:

The presentation of statements that are assumed or known to be true as premises for a conclusion that necessarily follows from those statements.



A **Deductive** Argument:

Every student at Spring Folly loves pizza.
 Larry is at Spring Folly.
 Therefore, Larry loves pizza.

 Therefore, the universe is designed







The **Bible**:

- Collection of authentic 1st century documents
- Eye-witness accounts
- Considered generally historically reliable

An Extra-Biblical Outline of Jesus:

- First Century Jewish man
- Considered a miracle worker
- Had disciples
- Ran contrary to religious leaders
- Was executed by Pontius Pilate



First-century historians were not asking if Jesus lived, but rather who he was.

Swoon Theory?

- Jesus' physical condition before crucifixion
- Josephus' account
- Roman Centurions
- The opinion of medical professionals



"Clearly, the weight of historical and medical evidence indicates that Jesus was dead before the would to his side was inflicted and supports the traditional view that the spear, thrust between his right ribs, probably perforated not only the right lung but also the pericardium and the heart...

Doubters WELCOME ...and thereby **ensuring his death.** Accordingly, interpretations based on the assumption that Jesus did not die on the cross appear to be at odds with modern medical knowledge."

Antony Flew (then atheist) reluctantly admitted that no alternative theories explain the resurrection. Yet, he concluded for Jesus to rise again is "impossible."







- Lineage: Abraham, David, Judah
- Birthplace (Micah 5:2)
- Virgin birth (Isa. 7:14)
- Serve others (Ps. 8:5-6)
- Would perform miracles (Isa. 35:5-6)



- Would be betrayed (Zech. 11:12-13)
- Would be abandoned (Ps. 41:9)

fulfilled (Luke 24:25-27)




