NOTE: The questions below are in order by chapter and verse, but in actual quizzing the order will be random

Question Who is rich in mercy in 2:4?

Answer God

Question What reasons are given for why no one can boast about salvation according to 2:8&9?

Answer It is **not your own doing**, it is the **gift of God**, and it is **not a result of works**

Note The answer to this question does not have to be a direct quotation, as long as key words

are included (bolded).

Question What has Christ broken down in his flesh in 2:14?

Answer The dividing wall of hostility

Question What did Christ preach to those who were far off and to those who were near in 2:17?

Answer Peace

Question What does Paul tell the Ephesians not to lose heart over in 3:13?

Answer What he/Paul is suffering for them/the Ephesians

Note 'He' or 'Paul' would be accepted, 'them' or 'the Ephesians' would be accepted.

Question Who does Paul bow his knees before in 3:14?

Answer The Father

7

Question Quote word perfect from the ESV Ephesians 3:20-21.

Answer Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think,

according to the power at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ

Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Note Ouizzers will have ONE CHANCE and AT MOST 30 SEC to recite the verse

PERFECTLY, NO CORRECTIONS ALLOWED.

TIP: 30 sec is plenty of time. Take your time and recite carefully!

Question How does Paul urge the Ephesians to bear with one another in 4:2?

Answer In love

Question This is a buzzable list: Which of the following is NOT one of the things that Paul writes

there is only one of in 4:4-6? Faith, Body, Baptism, Spirit, Priest, Lord, God and Father

of all

Answer Priest

Note For this type of question, quizzers MUST NOT buzz in before the QM has started stating

the list (if they do, a cross-over attempt will be given to the other team). However, ONCE THE LIST HAS BEGUN (the portion after the question mark), quizzers may buzz in AT ANY TIME, and they have ONE CHANCE to give the correct answer (they can still take 30 sec to think, but they can only give ONE answer, and if that answer is

wrong the other team will get a cross-over attempt).

Answer The apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers. **Note** All of the above must be included to answer the question correctly.

Question What are the Gentiles alienated from according to 4:18?

Answer The life of God

Note This section is about the Gentiles (vs 17), so 'they' at the beginning of vs 18 is referring

to the Gentiles

Question What is the thief to no longer do in 4:28?

Answer Steal

Question What are the Ephesians told to walk in according to 5:2?

Answer Love

Question How are the works of darkness described in 5:11?

Answer Unfruitful

Question Why are the Ephesians told to make the best use of the time in 5:16?

Answer Because the days are evil

Question What example are wives given for how they should submit in everything to their

husbands in 5:24?

Answer As the church submits to Christ

Question Who did Christ give himself up for in 5:25?

Answer The church

Question What are fathers instructed not to do in 6:4?

Answer Provoke their children to anger

Note The verse says "do not provoke **your** children to anger" – your or their would be

accepted

19

Question Why are the Ephesians told to put on the whole armor of God in 6:11?

Answer That they may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil

Note The verse says "that **you** may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil" -

you or they would be accepted

Question Who is the beloved brother mentioned in 6:21?

Answer Tychicus
